Packaging

Secure packaging and transport

Our new packaging system ensures that the plants will not be squeezed together during transport, limiting the risk of damages, broken leaves and fungus infections.



Rosette sizes

The provided sizes of the Echeveria are measured right after harvest. After harvest the cuttings are dried in order to prevent fungus and damaging during packaging and transportation. When the cuttings are received, you must expect that they have shrinking up to 20%. The cuttings will reach their original sizes as soon as they start to take up water and develop small roots after approximately 2 weeks.
